

2018 Canadian Formula 18 Championship

Notice of Race

The Sextant Marine Club in cooperation with the Canadian Formula 18 Association is the Organizing Authority.

Venue and Dates

The 2018 Canadian Formula 18 Championship will be held at Sextant Marine Sailing Club, 1608 Mckimmie, Clarenceville, Qc J0J1B0. The event dates are FRIDAY, August 31st, 2018 through MONDAY, September 3rd, 2018. Racing will take place on Lake Champlain. It s a four days event.

Rules

The 2018 Canadian Championship F 18 regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and by the rules as defined by the International Formula 18 Association with the exception that all Canadian Prescriptions, as outlined by The Canadian Formula 18 Class Association (CanF18) shall apply. Any other rule changes or modifications will be posted in the Sailing Instructions. A personal flotation device approved by the Canadian Coast Guard or the equivalent authority of the competitor's home country must be worn at all times while afloat, except for brief periods while adjusting clothing.

Eligibility

The ISAF Competitor's Eligibility Code applies (ISAF Regulation 19). The 2018 Canadian Formula 18 Championship is open to any Formula 18 as defined by the International Formula 18 Association. To compete in the 2018 Canadian Championship, both skipper and crew must be members in good standing of the Canadian Formula 18 Class Association.

Advertising

Advertising is not limited for the regatta as described in ISAF Regulation 20.

Entries and Registration

The Official Registration will be held from Thursday August 30th to Friday August 31st 9h30am. Please feel free to pre-registered by sending a email with skipper and crew name, NAT, and type of boats to sextantmarine@videotron.ca. Competitors aren't considered registered until all registration information, fees and waivers are signed and submitted.

Fees

Registration fees for this event are: 250\$ per team including registration, two dinners, BBQ& corn on cob for Monday, event t-shirt and awards

Check In, Weigh In

Check In and Weigh In will be held in the driveway entrance of the club. We ask all competitors to setup their boat on the open area on the other side of the street in front of the club. We want to avoid cars and trailers on site.

Boats will be weighed dry with all ready to sail equipments and mast down as defined in the Class Rules. Corrector weight, bailing sponges, tools and ditty bags are to be removed prior to weight in.

Competitor's Insurance

Each competitor must show proof of Liability Insurance with a minimum coverage in the amount of \$100,000.00 CAN. Competitors with foreign issued insurance policies must show proof that their insurance is valid while competing in the Canada. Competitor's proof of insurance and coverage must be provided at Check In.

On Site Check in and Weigh in Schedule- all times given is Eastern Standard Time

Thursday August 30th, 2018 15h-19h30 FRIDAY August 31st, 2018 0700-9h30

Teams must check in on site during the times indicated. Failure to do so may result in ineligibility to sail in the event.

The Sailing Instructions will be made available at on site check in.

Sailing Area and Courses

Launching Area is through the sailing club. The Sailing Area will be on Canadian 'side of the Lake Champlain. Courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

Around the bay race

The details of the Around the Bay race will be announced at the skipper's meeting on Monday morning

Awards

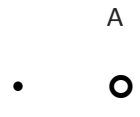
Awards will be presented for the F18 2018 Canadian Championship as follows:
